Preamble

On the occasion of its **centenary (1926-2026)**, the **Grande Mosquée de Paris** is establishing an **international arabic calligraphy competition** to celebrate a century of spiritual, cultural, and artistic influence.

Since its founding, the Grande Mosquée de Paris has been dedicated to **promoting Islamic arts**, particularly the noble art of **Arabic calligraphy**, a major expression of the aesthetic and intellectual tradition of Muslim civilization.

In this perspective, and **under the high patronage of the Rector, Chems-eddine Hafiz**, the competition entitled "Nûn" will be awarded to laureates to encourage, valorize, and transmit the excellence of Islamic arts.

This prize aims to support artists, preserve classical calligraphic traditions, and foster cultural dialogue through the beauty and rigor of this secular art.

Terms and Rules of Candidacy

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. **Any individual of any nationality**, who is of **legal age** under French law (**18 years old**) and capable of producing a work of classical Arab-Islamic calligraphy, may participate **individually**, provided they **respect the specific rules of this art** and the **conditions of these regulations**.
2. Each participant may compete in a **maximum of one style**. Any entry exceeding this limit will be canceled.

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

1. **Ink:** The use of **classical black ink** is **mandatory**.
2. **Paper:** Works must be produced on **light-colored paper**.
3. **Accepted Formats:**
 - **29.7 cm × 42 cm:** Thuluth, Naskh, Ta'liq, Diwani, and Kufi;
 - **20 × 30 cm:** Maghribi.Any work not respecting these dimensions will be rejected.

STYLES

The competition covers the styles detailed below. **Strict adherence to the text** and the **rules of each style** is mandatory:

1. Tuluth

Qalam: 2–5 mm maximum.

Layout: Parallel horizontal lines, no composition.

Format: 29.7 × 42 cm.

Qalam: 2–5 mm maximum.

Layout: Parallel horizontal lines.

Format: 29.7 × 42 cm.

Format: 21 cm × 29.7 cm.

Evaluation Criteria

Works will be **evaluated according to the classical rules** of calligraphy. Submissions will be **disqualified**, regardless of artistic quality, if they contain:

- Errors that alter the meaning of the text;
- Spelling mistakes;
- Non-compliance with the regulations.

It is strongly recommended to **carefully check** the spelling and vocalization of the verses.

Awards

The International Arabic Calligraphy Competition of the Grande Mosquée de Paris – 2026 – 1st Edition features a total prize fund of **€57,000**.

The Jury may choose not to award a prize or to award multiple prizes for the same rank.

Decisions of the Jury are **final**.

Prizes will be paid in **Euros** via **bank transfer**.

Copyright

1. Participation implies **acceptance of the regulations**.
2. **Award-winning or mentioned works become the property** of the Grand Mosque of Paris. **Patrimonial rights** (reproduction, publication, exhibition) are assigned to the institution.
3. Non-winning works may be collected in person within one year of the results announcement. After this period, they also become the property of the Grand Mosque of Paris.

3. **Submission Deadline (Works):** July 30, 2026
4. **Announcement of Results:** September 19, 2026

Application Procedures

Step 1: Submission of Registration Form

Candidates must **complete** (in french or in english), **sign**, and **submit the application form online** by **May 31, 2026**.

Applications without a signed form will be rejected.

Step 2: Sending the Works

1. The work must contain **no name, signature, or identification mark**.
2. The work must be sent **without ornamentation or gilding**.
3. The work must be **carefully packaged** to arrive flat, without folds or damage.
4. The original work must be sent **only by mail** (registered mail recommended) or **delivered in person** to the Secretariat by **July 30, 2026**, at the following address:
